	<p><b>Criterion 5:</b> Children whose parent's/guardian's principal private residence is in the School catchment area, but who are not attending St. Oliver Plunkett's, St. Andrew's, Pope John Paul II or Scoil an Duinnínigh primary schools. 14 applications / no offers made</p> <p><b>Criterion 6:</b> Children attending St. Oliver Plunkett's, St. Andrew's, Pope John Paul II or Scoil an Duinnínigh primary schools, whose parent's/guardian's principal private residence is outside the catchment area and who have siblings currently attending the School. 7 applications / no offers made.</p> <p><b>Criterion 7:</b> Children whose parent's/guardian's principal private residence is outside the catchment area with siblings attending the School. 1 application / no offer made.</p> <p><b>Criterion 8:</b> Any other applications received before the deadline as notified in the Annual Admission Notice. 1 application / no offers made.</p> <p><b>Criterion 9:</b> Applications received after the date set out for submission of applications in the Annual Admission Notice. 4 applications / no offers made.</p>

\* Please note that following a special request from the Department of Education in July, 2021, the Board of Management agreed to enrol 224 students for this academic year only. The Board has respectfully concurred that the school will not be in a position to facilitate a similar request for the academic school year 2022 - 2023, given the subsequent timetabling and structural constraints.

\*\*Please note that on average, over the past five years, Malahide Community School has been in a position to offer a place to applicant no. 35 on the waiting list, whilst adhering to our agreed maximum enrolment of 204 places.
