(1) Following extensive negotiations between the Board of Management and the Department of Education, sufficient additional teaching resources were allocated which enabled the Board to agree on May 29th 2024 to enrol 224 students for the academic year 2024-2025 only. The Board will not be able to facilitate a similar request for the academic school year 2025-2026 given the subsequent space and timetabling constraints.
