Application for our Mainstream Classes is via an <u>online application</u> form (after 14:00hrs) on that date. Application for our Autism Special Class is via a <u>downloadable form</u> that has to be submitted manually.

Application and Decision Dates for admission to 2026-2027 school year

The following are the dates applicable for admission to First Year:

The school will commence accepting applications for admission on	Wednesday, 1st October, 2025 at 14:00hrs
The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on	Wednesday, 22nd October, 2025 at 18:00hrs
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is (* final decision for admission to the Autism Special Class rests with the NCSE)	Wednesday, 12th November, 2025 at 18:00hrs *
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is	Monday, 24th November, 2025, at 18:00hrs

Note: the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

*Failure to accept an offer within the prescribed period above will result in the offer being withdrawn.

Number of Offers made and accepted under each criterion by the initial acceptance deadline of Monday 25th November, 2024:

Criterion 1: Children whose parent's / guardian's principal private residence is in the School's catchment area, who are attending St. Oliver Plunkett's, St. Andrew's, Pope John Paul II, Scoil an Duinnínigh or Malahide Portmarnock Educate Together National school and who have siblings currently attending the School. 94 applications / 94 offers made / subsequently 88 places accepted.

Criterion 2: Children of MCS day staff: 3 applications / 3 offers made / subsequently 3 places accepted.

Criterion 3: Subject to a maximum *25% of the enrolment figure, children whose parent's/guardian's principal private residence is in the School catchment area, who are attending St. Oliver Plunkett's, St. Andrew's, Pope John Paul II, Scoil an Duinnínigh or Malahide Portmarnock Educate Together National School and whose parent(s) / guardian(s) completed their post-primary education in the School to either Intermediate/Junior Certificate and/or Leaving Certificate level. 34 Applications / 34 offers made / subsequently 31 places accepted.

Criterion 4: children whose parent's/guardian's principal private residence is in the School catchment area, who are attending St. Oliver Plunkett's, St. Andrew's, Pope John Paul II, Scoil an Duinnínigh or Malahide Portmarnock Educate Together National schools: 104 Applications / 67 offers made / subsequently 61 places accepted.

Criterion 5: Children whose parent's/guardian's principal private residence is in the School catchment area, but who are not attending St. Oliver Plunkett's, St. Andrew's, Pope John Paul II, Scoil an Duinnínigh or Malahide Portmarnock Educate Together National schools. 15 applications / no offers made

Criterion 6: Children attending St. Oliver Plunkett's, St. Andrew's, Pope John Paul II, Scoil an Duinnínigh or Malahide Portmarnock Educate Together National schools, whose parent's/guardian's principal private residence is outside the catchment area and who have siblings currently attending the School. 2 applications / no offers made.

Criterion 7: Children whose parent's/guardian's principal private residence is outside the catchment area with siblings attending the School. No applications / no offers made.

Criterion 8: Any other applications received before the deadline as notified in the Annual Admission Notice. 56 applications / no offers made.

Criterion 9: Applications received after the date set out for submission of applications in the Annual Admission Notice. 1 applications / no offers made.
